At Beechoak Farm we have 3 pathways for our fees.

Free Entitlement Place

We offer one Free Entitlement Place. This allows your child to attend the sessions stated below and we do not charge for the free entitlement place.

The registration fee and deposit do not apply for a Free Entitlement Place

Part Funded: 2FEEEW (2-Year-Old Funding for Working Parents)

Some children are eligible the term after their 2nd birthday.

Parents must check they are eligible and supply Beechoak Farm with their National Insurance Number and 11-digit eligibility code issued by HMRC.

If eligible your child will be allocated 15 hours of funding per week for 38 weeks a year i.e. 570 hours per year

We stretch the funding over 51 weeks a year. The hours will be spread over 2 (9am-4pm) days maximum, with 5 hours and 35 minutes allocated to each day.

Part Funded: Universal 3 and 4-Year-Old FEEE

Every child is eligible the term after their 3rd birthday.

Your child will be allocated 15 hours of funding per week for 38 weeks a year i.e. 570 hours per year
We stretch the funding over 51 weeks a year. The hours will be spread over 2 (9am-4pm) days maximum, with 5 hours and 35 minutes allocated to each day.

Extended Entitlement for 3 and 4-Year-Olds (30-hours)

Some children will be eligible for the extended Entitlement for 3 and 4-year-olds. This is an additional 15 hours of funding per week for 38 weeks of the year.

Parents must check they are eligible and supply Beechoak Farm with their National Insurance Number and 11-digit eligibility code.

We stretch the funding over 51 weeks a year. The hours will be spread over 2 (9am-4pm) days maximum, with 5 hours and 35 minutes allocated to each day, across a maximum of 4 days.

Please see below the number of hours Beechoak will claim for an eligible child.

2 Days Per Week	15 Hours Claimed
3 Days per Week	22.5 Hours Claimed
4 Days per Week	30 Hours Claimed

Unused hours can be shared with another provider.

Standard Fees

Standard fees are for children who are not entitled to funding, any sessions that exceed a child's funded entitlement or any adhoc sessions.

Session	Hours	Fee
School Day (inclusive of lunch)	9.00am - 4.00pm	£68.15
Full Day (inclusive of breakfast, lunch and tea)	8.00am - 5.00pm	£91.25
Breakfast or Tea	8.00am - 9.00am 4.00pm - 5.00pm	£11.55

Further Information

- * All fees are subject to annual review.
- * Please see terms and conditions for late collection charge.
- * Beechoak Farm requires a £500 deposit for part-funded and standard fee places. Beechoak will require a further £250 holding deposit for part-funded and standard fee siblings. This will be topped up when the eldest child leaves.
- * 5% sibling discount- whilst both siblings attend.
- * Out of school day hours care is available from 8am to 9am and 4pm to 5pm. This needs to be agreed in advance.
- * Additional breakfast and tea clubs are non-refundable or transferable.
- * We reserve the right to close in exceptional circumstances e.g. Extreme weather conditions and events that are out of Beechoak Farm's control. This could be for a maximum of two days per year (January to December) and these will be chargeable.
- * We close for all bank holidays and the period between Christmas and New Year. These days are not chargeable.
